Hi Neighbors:

This is just a reminder of the up coming **City Council Meeting on Tuesday November 27 at 7:00 pm**. Oscar Bzurto of our Steering Committee will be making our first presentation to the Council and we need as many of us there as possible. The presentation will be an alternative to what Fairfield Development presented last November 15 which, if you missed it is on the back side. The Current Fairfield Presentation consist of an average of 52 Single Family Homes, 230 Town Home Units, 573 Apartments Units for a total of 855 Units. All This adds up, using their figures, to 2,138 People, 1539 Cars which will generate 12,620 Car Trips per day on our streets. The 855 units is over 40 units per acre and the Single Family Homes are like putting 3 Homes on each of our lots in the Pepper Tree Neighborhood.

As you can see we have a lot of work to get done and The Steering Committee is currently working on many approaches. It consists of the following people:
